

(3) *The City has adopted by reference the City of Conroe's industrial pre-treatment requirements codified as Article II, Chapter 20, Code of Ordinances, City of Conroe, dealing with discharge of industrial waste, together with such amendments thereto as the City Council of the City of Conroe, Texas shall from time-to-time adopt. A copy of "Article II. Discharge of Industrial Waste", as found in the City of Conroe's Code of Ordinances is attached hereto and incorporated herewith to this Ordinance.*

2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, including Ordinance No. 79-93, as amended, which is in conflict in part or in whole with the City of Conroe's industrial pre-treatment requirements are hereby repealed.
3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 99-251

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF PANORAMA VILLAGE, TEXAS,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 79-93,
AS AMENDED, REGULATING DEPOSIT OF WASTE INTO THE PUBLIC SEWERS
AND REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF INDUSTRIAL WASTES INTO THE
SANITARY SEWERS OF THE CITY OF PANORAMA VILLAGE;
ADDING AND INCORPORATING THE UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR WASTE
WATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT FACILITIES OF THE CITY OF CONROE,
CODE OF ORDINANCES, "ARTICLE II. DISCHARGE OF INDUSTRIAL WASTE;"
REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING SAVINGS CLAUSE;
AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of the City of Panorama Village that as part of its Interlocal Agreement with the City of Conroe to provide excess sewage treatment, the City of Panorama Village will adopt the City of Conroe industrial pre-treatment requirements codified as Article II, Chapter 20, Code of Ordinances, City of Conroe, Texas, dealing with discharge of industrial waste, together with such amendments as the City Council of the City of Conroe, Texas shall from time-to-time adopt; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of such industrial pre-treatment requirements by the City of Panorama Village is deemed to be in the best interest of the safety, health and welfare of its citizens;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PANORAMA VILLAGE, TEXAS THAT:

1. City Ordinance No. 79-93, Article II, Section 16, as amended, is hereby amended by adding a new subparagraph three (3) to read as follows:


