CURBSIDE GARBAGE SERVICE

Service days are Thursday

Please have your WM cart out by 7A.M. on your service day.

Household garbage and yard waste are collected in the WM Green LID cart at the curb and all materials are limited to the cart.



BULK TRASH COLLECTION **FIRST BULK DAY MAY 2, 2019**

Ten (10) items on the **FIRST THURSDAY** of each Month

Acceptable items include moving boxes (please break them down and bundle them), old furniture, and appliances. *Note: moving boxes are recyclable if they are cut and placed in recycling cart.*

Please note! WM can no longer dispose of CFC refrigerant containing items (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.) without certification that the Freon has been properly removed and recycled, pursuant to current Federal law. **Important!** For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we do require that branches and tree trimmings be no greater than three inches (3") in diameter and be cut, tied and bundled in four-foot (4') lengths weighing no more than forty to fifty pounds (40-50 lbs.)

Plastic Bottles & Containers #1-5 & 7

Brown paper bags, non-confidential office paper, newspaper, magazines



Paper Cardboard, Dairy & Juice Containers



Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard



Glass Bottles & Jars

RECYCLE RIGHT:

Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled:



DO NOT INCLUDE: Food waste, plastic bags, or polystyrene foam cups & containers

Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris.

Paper food containers must be rinsed out, no caps.

Tissues, paper towels or other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.

Make sure food contamination and caps are removed from cans and plastics and all containers are empty.

Separate plastic lids from plastic bottles (often made from different materials)

Keep medical waste (syringes, needles) out of recycling containers or place in safe disposal containers like Waste Management's MedWaste Tracker® box.
