

## Panorama Bake-off Rules and Regulations 2019 THEME: "Let Freedom Ring"

## **CONTEST INFORMATION:**

Present your dessert entry for judging from 9:00-9:45 am on **Thursday, July 4th** at the Clubhouse. Judging will start at 10:00 am and winners announced following the judging. **Desserts must be picked up at the Clubhouse by 12:00 pm.** 

Official Rules and Regulations: Participant must live in Panorama Village or have a relative living in Panorama to be an eligible contestant.

- 1. The 2019 theme is "Let Freedom Ring". Desserts entered in this competition must depict this theme. Entries will be judged on the following criteria: Taste (20 points), Originality (10 points), Adherence to Theme (10 points), Presentation & Plating (10 points), <u>10 points will be deducted for late entries</u>. The highest cumulative point winner shall be declared the Grand First Prize Winner.
- 2. **Instructions:** Contestants submit their dessert including recipe no earlier than 9:00 am and no later than 9:45 am on **Thursday**, **July 4**, **2019** in the clubhouse dining room. Contestants will complete on-site registration where they will be given a numeric identification tag that corresponds to their dessert entry, so that the contestant remains anonymous during judging. Desserts should be prepared to serve 6 people.
- 3. Recipes: Recipe submissions must be typed and contain the following parts: A) Dessert name and Inspiration / History of this dessert, B) Ingredients and Portions C) Method of preparation. Recipes will be identified by the contestant's unique entry number and will not be distributed or reproduced without the contestant's permission.
- 4. Presentation and Plating: Contestants are encouraged to be creative, however, any plating or presentation technique considered dangerous or otherwise hazardous will be cause for disqualification. Please avoid potentially harmful techniques. Par baking, table side finishing and other live preparation methods are prohibited—all entries must be completed before presentation. All desserts must be removed from the clubhouse by 12:00 pm on Thursday, July 4th.
- 5. Tasting: The Judges will view the desserts presented whole, and will sample the dessert for taste. A recipe is required with presentation so judges may review ingredients used for potential allergens. Shelf unstable entries will be tasted in early groups, i.e. those entries requiring cold storage; all others in order of submission. There is no provision for cold storage of entries and they must removed immediately after the judging.
- 6. **Foodborne illness / Safe handling guidelines**: Contestants are responsible for providing safe and edible entries to the judges and through their entry, accept all liability in the event of personal injury or other loss-claim. The Village Golf Club (clubhouse) and the City of Panorama Village are not liable for any damages that result from a contestant's entry.
- 7. **Eligibility of Contestants:** This contest is open to anyone who can reasonably execute the recipe for the dessert they present.
- 8. **Rule of Judges:** In the event of a tie for points, the judging panel shall make a final decision as to the winner. Judges also reserve the right to disqualify contestants for noncompliance with other rules and regulations of the competition.
- 9. **Prizes:** City of Panorama will provide the prize money. Winners will be announced immediately following judging.
