

Storm Water Management Program

The City of Panorama has implemented a *Storm Water Management Program* which is available for review at the Panorama Village City Hall located at 99 Hiwon Drive, Panorama Village, TX 77304. One of the goals of this program is to educate residents of hazards associated with the improper disposal of waste and other measures to prevent negative effects to the water quality of our streams and water bodies.

Community Outreach

The City of Panorama Village takes pride in our community and environment. The following are ways residents can help reduce negative environmental impact.

- Report illegal dumping - Please contact the City Secretary, Lisa Evans, at **936-856-2821**, if you notice anything suspicious, see illegal dumping, or see anyone dumping materials/liquids into sewer manholes. The after-hours phone number is **936-856-7777**.
- Pet waste – Pet waste can have a negative effect during rain events. Storm water runoff will collect bacteria and convey it to streams and bodies of water. Please collect your pet waste and dispose of it down the toilet or by wrapping it in plastic and disposing it in the trash.
- Yard waste – Keeping your yard clean of excess grass clippings and leaves can reduce the likelihood yard waste from entering into streams and bodies of water. Please collect all yard waste by disposing it in the trash.
- Medication – Do not flush medications down toilets, or sink. When medications are flushed into the sewer lines, the City's wastewater treatment facilities are not designed to eliminate medications. Therefore, these medications will wind up in streams and bodies of water which will have a negative effect on fish and other animals. Please consult with your pharmacy for more information on properly disposing unused medication.
- Automotive Fluids – Ensure your vehicles are inspected for fluid leaks which may leak onto pavement or the ground. By properly disposing of automotive fluids and ensuring your vehicle is in good repair, you will help protect the water quality of our streams and bodies of water.
